

I have been boating in the waters covered by this cruising guide since the early 1970's and I have stayed on my boat Seawolf in all the harbours mentioned that do not dry and have visited most of those that do dry and my big wish would have been to have the Channel Islands, Cherbourg Peninsula and North Brittany cruising guide available to me.

It would have made my life a lot easier to have such full detail, not only of the ports but the anchorages, the entry channels, the tidal flow, the visitor moorings, entry and berthing, appropriate warnings, depths and furthermore very useful detail on distances between the south coast of England and the region, distances between places in the region and most useful of all, passages with their course to steer, not only with the degrees, but also with charts showing the actual passage.



The other good point is that whilst it has all the

technical information that experienced yachtsmen need, it has been written with the whole crew in mind; less experienced yachtsmen will find it easier to read and use.

I have never seen a cruising guide of such good quality. It will become the 'essential guide' for anybody visiting the region. It covers everything, not only the navigation and port details but also the essential information on the rock reefs such as the Ecrehous and the Minquiers.

As an added attraction it also gives you very useful landside information on the areas including some historical detail.

A big congratulations to the Royal Cruising Club Pilotage Foundation for promoting such a useful guide and to Peter Carnegie for his initial guide and to Annabel Finding for her updating.

I have seen many cruising guides for many regions but never anything as informative and useful as this, especially as it is put together in a very readable way and with excellent photographs and charts.
