The Royal Navy's P2000 Class Patrol Boat HMS Trumpeter will be berthed at the club during a talk organised by the Royal Institute of Navigation's Solent Branch. Under the command of Lt Richie Gray, Trumpeter's prime role is the training of RN Midshipmen based at Bristol University.

Trumpeter will sail from Gosport on the Thursday morning with her own trainees onboard, plus local Sea Cadets out for a day's experience at sea. She will return the following day with youngsters from a Lyminster school.

She will be berthed at the club and open to visitors prior to the evening talk (on the first transatlantic flight, by Alcock and Brown).
