

Friday Evening Informal Racing

For 2017 Castle Cove Sailing Club has again teamed up with RNSA Portland to host informal racing on a Friday evening in Portland Harbour and, if fine, Weymouth Bay.

It is aimed principally at cruisers looking to get on the water for a fun and relaxed sail around the buoys, those who typically wouldn't participate in the Wednesday evening racing.



It is open to all Weymouth club members as well as visitors, and represents a good opportunity to those new to racing to have a go and learn a bit about it.

Races commence at approximately 1830 from the northern side of the harbour, run for up to an hour and a half, after which all participants are invited back to CCSC where a bar and a "bring your own food" bbq will be waiting.

A race is planned broadly every fortnight during the summer, on the following dates which are designed not to coincide with CCSC cruising:

- May 5 and 19
- June 2 and 16
- July 7, 21 and 28
- August 11 and 18
- September 1
