

COVID RESTRICTED OPENING

The RNSC will be re-opening on the 29th June 2020 in a restricted system which allows us to continue to maintain social distancing as guided by the GOV. All users should maintain social distancing at all times. The RNSC clubhouse facilities will not be available during this time accept to contact the OIC.

The Centre will be allowing use of its sailing fleet for Recreation Only and only by Qualified and SUITABLY EXPERIENCED sailors. The craft will be rotated to maintain where possible a 72 hr down period between use.

RISK MITIGATION

CHANGES TO NORMAL OPERATION PROCEDURES

All our normal SOP's should be adhered too however we have introduced some enhanced changes.

Safety Cover is not available except in an emergency, or for towing, our staff should not be placed in a position where they are required to break the GOV distancing guides so access to the water will be restricted by weather conditions more than normal. We will not be allowing people to go afloat in stronger wind conditions which may hold a higher chance of capsize.

6 STAGE PROCESS

Once a booking has been made customers should not arrive on site earlier than the agreed time slot. A 6 stage process is posted around site and MUST BE ADHERED TO AT ALL TIMES.

- 1. On arrival go direct to reception NOT the CHANGING ROOMS
- 2. Sign out craft and kit (Please bring your own where possible)
- 3. Once kit is signed out take it all away and get changed using the wet entrance only (Code 531 from bottom up)
- 4. Once changed go sailing (Only use the craft allocated if U/S call reception)
- 5. After Sailing (DO NOT BRING BOAT KIT UP YOU DID NOT TAKE DOWN) go straight to changing room do not go to reception.
- 6. Once ready to leave, return to reception place clothing in Dunk bin (DO NOT REMOVE IT), spray down any foils and sign back in. NOW GO HOME.

MORE INFORMATION

We will only be allowing 2 Male units and 2 Female units afloat during each session. A unit is an individual or more from the same house / social bubble as designated by the current GOV Covid-19 directive, this minimizes the numbers in our small changing facilities.

You can book more than one slot however the centre reserves the right to stop this if we find a large interest in getting afloat.

Sailors must have left site before 1300 Mon - Wed.

These rules **MUST** be Adhered to at all times and we reserve the right to change the process as the COVID - 19 crisis develops. We have been asked to operate **a 1 strike system** for safety, anyone failing to follow the systems in place run the risk of endangering others and will unhappily be asked to wait for restrictions to be lifted before returning.
